Mercy heritage and history

The Sisters of Mercy were founded by an unselfish young woman – Catherine McAuley – who used her inheritance to open Houses of Mercy in Dublin in the 1800s. Thus began the Mercy mission of providing exceptional care to others through Christian ministry.

In 1884 – just a few years before the Oklahoma Land Run of 1889 – five Sisters of Mercy made a long trek by covered wagon into Indian Territory. They crossed raging rivers, encountered outlaws and survived tornadoes, but the Sisters of Mercy

never turned back. Today, Mercy has more than 30,000 co-workers who continue the legacy of care and compassion started by the Sisters of Mercy years ago.

For this ministry to continue, each co-worker is called to embody the spirit of Mercy through

interactions big and small. They recognize their unique role in caring for others and know that the foundation laid by the Sisters of Mercy more than 100 years ago is exemplified each day through their actions.
